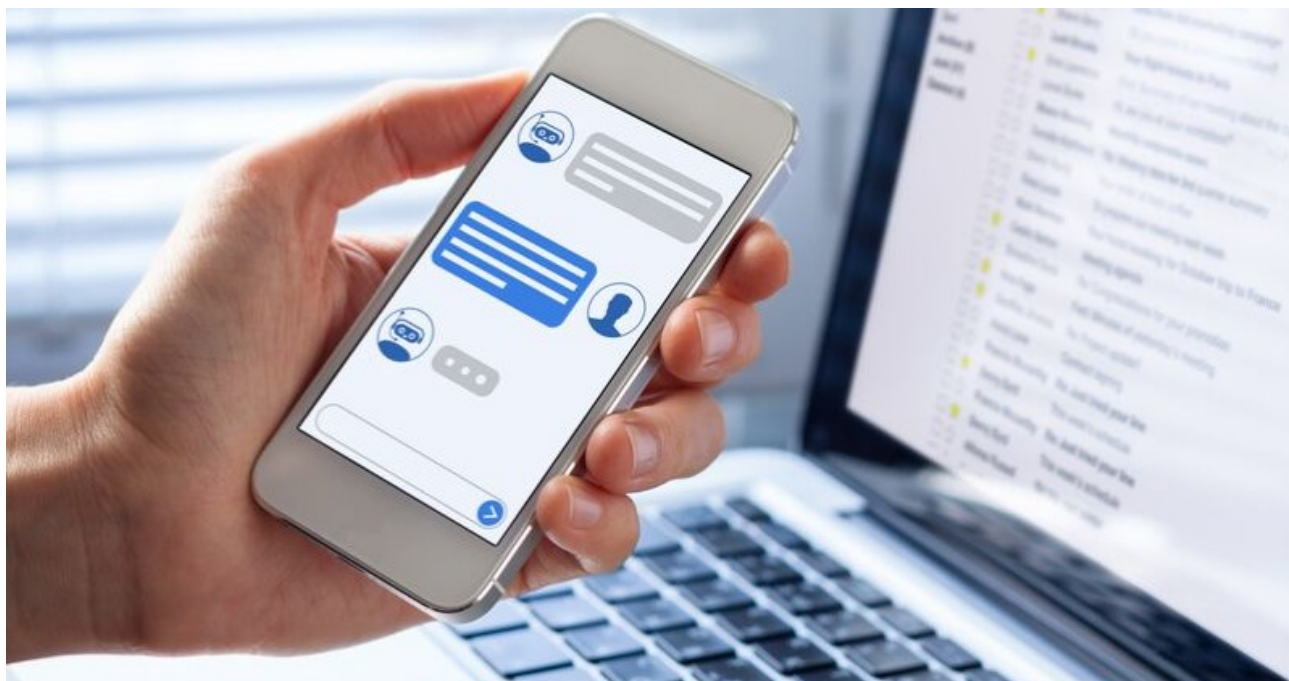


5 Sales Tasks You Can Delegate To a Virtual Assistant
